Thank you so much for your generous donation—which has allowed us to purchase vital equipment for our Moorabbin kitchen garden. Wheelbarrows, trolleys, pruners, hoses, and other tools are essential for our volunteers to plant out, maintain, and harvest produce in our gardens.

FareShare cooks 25,000 meals every week for Victorians in need. We strive to make wholesome and nutritious meals that can provide as much nourishment as possible to people experiencing food poverty. This can be challenging without a regular supply of quality ingredients – such as fresh vegetables.

FareShare's three kitchen gardens were established to help us overcome this shortfall.

Our gardens have produced more than **26 tonnes** of fresh, healthy, home-grown veg since we planted our first seeds in March last year. We now grow more than **one third** of the veggies needed to meet our production targets in the kitchen.

Your donation will help us grow more veggies to boost the nutrition of our meals for people who have fallen on hard times.

People like Anna, who wrote to FareShare: **“Sometimes I get lunch and dinner, sometimes just dinner, now and then nothing, depends on the timing of bills and pay.”** Anna told us how FareShare's ham and tomato pasta that she received from a local community house provided her with meals she would not otherwise have had: **“FareShare was literally the difference of something or nothing on my plate today. Thank you.”**
