The Rotary Foundation Trustees raised the amount available for 2019-20; 2020-21 district grants. Districts may use up to 20 percent of their uncommitted funds from past years (their "rollover DDF") as calculated on 1 July 2018. Also, there are many and diverse things that are being done in the world that would tick the box for the many things that people are interested in.
