Guest Speaker – Cathy Emerson – Nokor Tep Women's Hospital, Cambodia and Rotary Donations in Kind

Cathy was introduced by friend Dianne Taranto. Cathy became aware of the need for improved hospital services in Cambodia while living in Singapore and travelling in Cambodia. She has been a member of a support group fundraising to build a new women's hospital specialising in gynecology and female oncology care. The first stage of the modern hospital opened in April 2019 financed mainly by donations.

Cathy also described the work of Rotary Donations in Kind that is a multi-district project with a storage large building in Footscray that receives donation of used goods and equipment and sends them to hospitals and other causes in Asia and the Pacific area.

Cliff Riley proposed the thanks and Paul Taranto presented the club's cheque for \$1600 to cover the cost of 20 refurbished laptop computers obtained from Donations in Kind.
