Kathy Thompson summarised some highlights from the RI Convention in Hamburg and instanced the emphasis on youth programs, sustainability programs in Africa and a program to assist refugees in Germany

## Guest Speaker - Paul Smith "Recycling today and problems facing the industry"

Paul is the CEO of KS Environmental Group and provided an overview of waste management in Victoria and the affect of recent bans on exporting waste overseas.

Currently about 12.9 million tonnes of domestic waste is produced in Victoria each year. Of this, 68% was recycled with a 72% resource recovery rate. Until recently, most of the world's plastics wastes was sent to China. In 2016 China gave notice that it would be restricting the amount of plastics they import although initially governments and councils took little notice.

The ban is now in place and China is much stricter in what they will accept. Contamination and mixing of different types of plastic are major issues. While. Governments are now funding solutions, in the short term, burying waste is the best option while in the longer term changes to procurement and packaging are needed. Glenyse Cooper proposed the thanks.
